What: Business Start-up and Management Training and Mentorship Program.

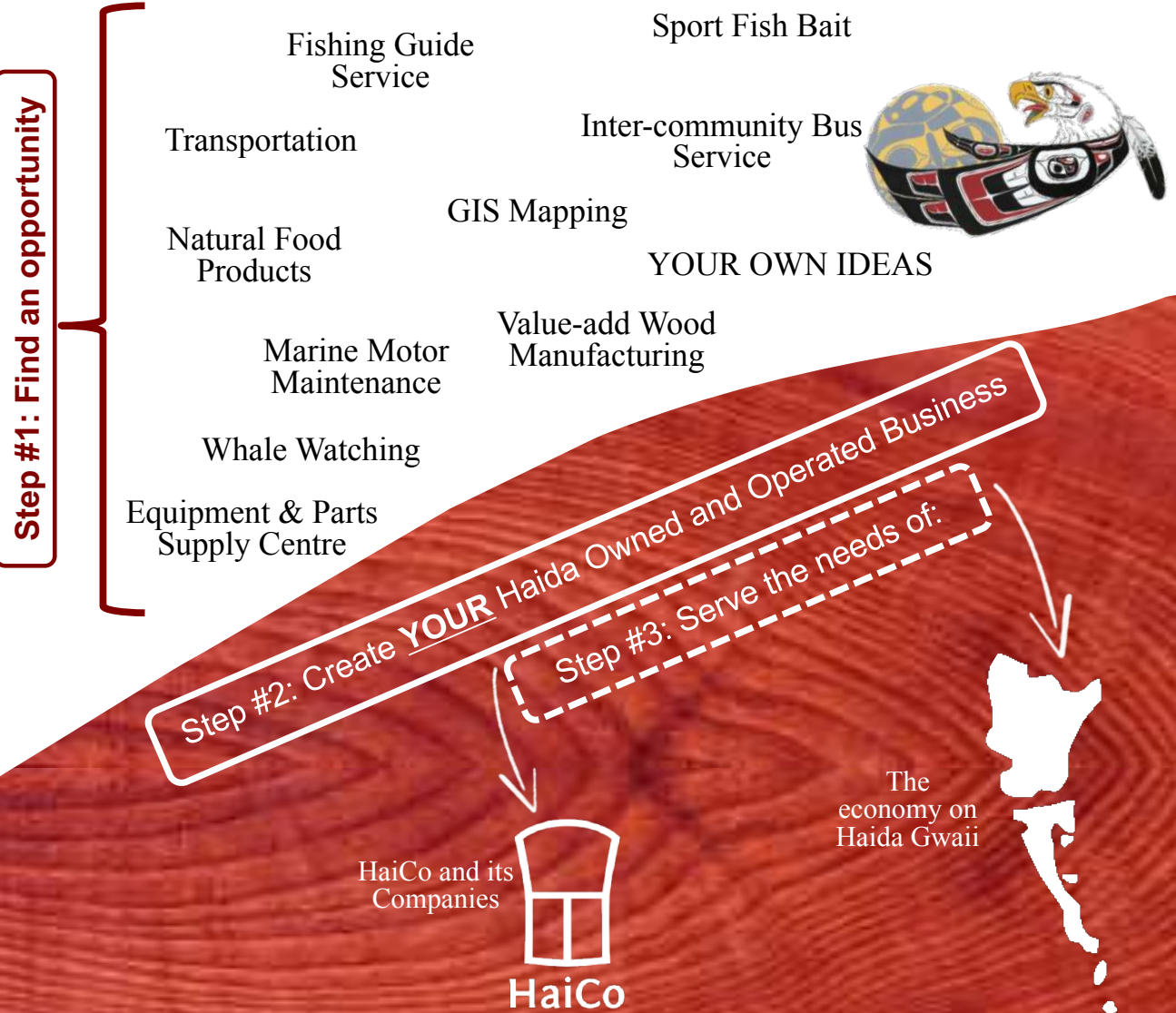
Where and When: The program starts Sept 16, 2017 and ends March 11, 2018.

Classes are held every second weekend with mentorship and application of principles during the week. The program breaks for the Christmas holidays.

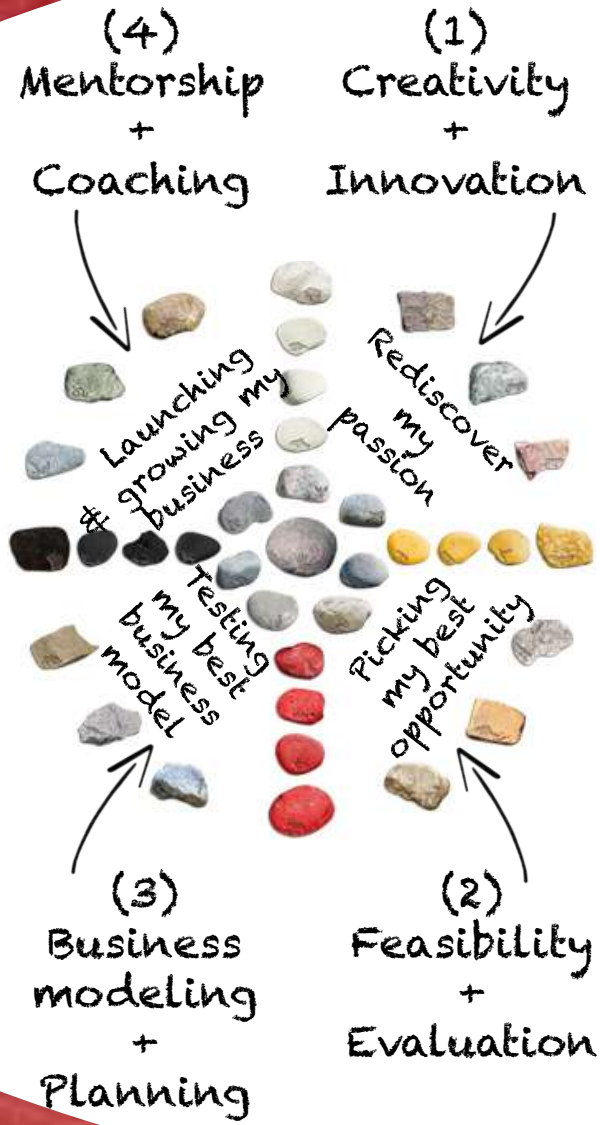
Classes may be rotated between Skidegate and Old Masset.
